SUBJECT: Prohibited Garments in the Dining Facility

1. In accordance with AFI 36-2903, *Dress and Appearance*, the following items and styles of dress are prohibited based on legal, moral, safety, or sanitary grounds. Prohibited wear is as follows:
 - a. Undergarments worn as outer garments.
 - b. Sleeveless or midriff baring shirts, to include tank tops.
 - c. Any garments which obtain obscene, profane, lewd words or drawings or any sheer or see through materials.
 - d. Ripped, torn, or patched clothing.
 - e. Bathing suits, cut-off shorts, or pajamas.
 - f. Bare feet, shower shoes, or shoes that expose the feet (strapped sandals may be worn with socks).
 - g. Individuals with poor personal hygiene that may be offensive in nature (example, dirty clothing, unwashed outer skin and hair exposure).
 - h. All headgear (exception: 319 SFS personnel while in performance of official duty).
 - i. Midnight meal patrons must adhere to the above clothing guideline, but are not required to be in military uniform.
2. The dining facility staff is authorized to refuse service to anyone who disregards the standards, and patrons will be asked to depart the facility. There will be no exceptions to the policy.
